- 8 • The governments' interest in increasing surveillance in order to create safer public spaces and prevent criminal actions
 - 9 • The fast-paced widespread of surveillance especially in China but also in the EU
 - 10 • that Human Rights can be diminished through the implementation of surveillance

11 Considering that

- 13 • Surveillance further establishes dictatorships (e.g. China)
 - 14 • Sensible data can be easily misused by governments
 - 15 • Individual privacy decreases tremendously
 - 16 • Democracies can be endangered by surveillance (e.g. hesitation to participate in anti-governmental demonstrations)
 - 17 • Surveillance enables governments to be more powerful therefore personal freedom will
 - 18 be endangered

19 Recommends that

- 20
- 21 • surveillance should be to banned from all protests and demonstrations
 - 22 • citizens should have the possibility to ask for deleting their own biometric data
 - 23 • data gained from the surveillance should be automatically deleted after one month if it is not legally relevant
 - 24 • all processes and data gains involving surveillance should be transparent and all citizens should have access to the data concerning them
 - 25 • before any data can be used judicial acceptance has to take place
 - 26 • every government body should only have access to a specific area of data in order to protect personal freedom
 - 27 • surveillance should only be used for protection purposes
 - 28 • data protection should be fully covered by the law
